Purpose

The purpose of this document is to outline the basic role and responsibilities of a Natural Gas Facility Operator for Wild Goose Storage facility and the associated reporting structure. It is not the intent of this document to specify all duties associated with the position, but to give a general understanding of the expectations and capabilities the position carries.

Position Description

Reporting to the Gas Storage Production Coordinator, and as part of the Wild Goose Gas Storage team, the successful candidate will ensure the safe, reliable and efficient operation of the Gas Storage and field facilities. This position requires a self-motivated, hands-on individual with strong team skills.

Note: This position is located in Gridley, California. The successful candidate must reside within one hour of the plant site.

Typical Duties and Responsibilities

- Troubleshoot and repair process problems and identify opportunities for improvement and optimization.
- Monitor and control plant and field processing conditions utilizing SCADA control systems.
- Monitor and optimize gas well and pipeline operations.
- Perform minor maintenance and coordinate other maintenance activities.
- Understand and perform safety, environmental and regulatory responsibilities such as hazard identification, equipment lockout, emergency response, implement safe work procedures, etc.
- Ensure effective communication with operations, maintenance and leadership staff.

- Maintain proper documentation including operator log, maintenance records, and safety and environment reports.
- Maintain superior housekeeping standards throughout the plant process and control room areas.
- Ongoing development including job progression, site-specific training, process training, etc.

Requirements

- High school diploma with 5 years gas processing experience or equivalent would be an asset.
- A valid driver's license.
- Operational and maintenance experience in gas compression, dehydration, pipelines and gas well equipment as well as a basic understanding of well performance and reservoir behavior would be an asset.
- Team player with strong problem solving, interpersonal, organizational and communication skills.
- Ability and confidence to work with minimal supervision.
- Self motivated with a strong work ethic and demonstrated ability to learn and take on a variety of operational challenges.
- Experience with commissioning and startup of new equipment would be an asset.
- Proficiency in the use of Word, Excel, and Outlook would be an asset.
