





The Lodi Gas Storage, L.L.C. Safety Plan includes provisions to comply with GO 112-F Subpart G.

Whistleblower Notice

Any employee or independent contractor of Lodi Gas Storage, who in good faith, believes that unsafe conditions, services or facilities of the utility threaten the health or safety of its patrons, the employees or the public, has the right to report the conditions to the California Public Utilities Commission. The employee can report the conditions by calling the Commission's Whistleblower Hotline at 1(800) 649-7570, either anonymously or by giving the employee's name, or by sending an e-mail with the pertinent facts and / or documentation to safetyhotline@cpuc.ca.gov. This requirement shall be in addition to any right the employee has to contact any other State or Federal agency, if the employee has reasonable cause to believe that the information discloses a violation of a state or federal statute, or a violation or noncompliance with a state or federal rule or regulations. The California Public Utilities Commission prohibits California natural gas utilities from retaliating against any employee, who reports, in good faith, unsafe conditions to the Commission.
